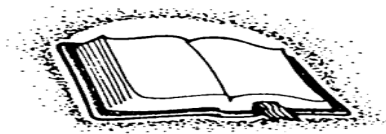

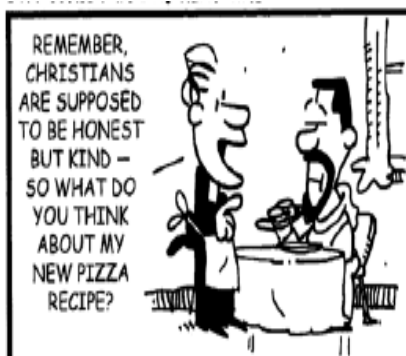

DID YOU KNOW? Catholic Charities, of Toledo Diocese provides services and assistance to Catholics and non-Catholics with various programs. From Father Jason's Desk.....

Dear Families and Friends of St. Mary's Parish,

Last Sunday – May 30th – I celebrated one year of being a priest for the Diocese of Toledo! Thank you all for your kind words, cards of congratulations, prayers, and overall support for me in my ministry. It was a wonderful year filled with surprises, challenges, and much joy. I look forward to many more fulfilling and life-giving years as a priest serving the people of God.

Over the past few years, your input and ideas have been sought regarding how we can become better at serving the needs of our parish family. And with such events as the Kalahari Gathering (Fall 2008) and the 23 Home Listening Sessions last summer that Fr. Dave and I attended, one specific priority continued to come up: **making our parish more welcoming, family-friendlier, and better orientated to the needs of young families.** Well, we've listened and we try to continue to listen, welcome, and value your opinions. And one opinion that you've expressed, which our overall goal is too, is to help foster a more comfortable experience for Sunday Mass especially for younger families so that they will be encouraged to join us regularly.

Over many, many months, several groups of parishioners and committees have been meeting and discussing ways to make your ideas and opinions a reality. These groups include the Building and Grounds Committee, Arts and Environment Committee, the parish's Administrative Team, and various young families within St. Mary's Parish.

As a result, we have recently added four comfortable chairs with two end tables to the vestibule area at the main entrance of the church. Already, several young parents have expressed a sense of gratitude for a comfortable and welcoming space as their parenting duties sometimes require them to temporarily step out of the main body of the church. And since the vestibule is already wired with sound, parents remain connected with the Mass while they are attending to their children's specific needs.

Over the coming months, the Mary and Joseph statues will be repainted to match the beautiful Gothic interior of our historic church. Once this is done, they will return to their original locations in the front of the church in the shrines that currently hold the Sacred Heart statues of Jesus and Mary. These Sacred Heart statues will then be given a new home in church as well. Doing this will provide us with various opportunities to consider additional ways in which the vestibule might become an even more comfortable place for younger families.

You also may have noticed that the Pieta Statue has been moved to a more prominent and fitting place in the Blessed Sacrament Chapel. This new location invites continued and special devotion to the Blessed Mother, Our Lady of Sorrows, as well as to her Son, Jesus Christ, in the Blessed Sacrament. We hope you will make your way there often to ask for the intercession of our parish patroness and Mother of God.

All in all, as we move ahead, we will continue to listen and discuss various ways in which our church might become better at serving the needs of younger families and all the members of our parish family.

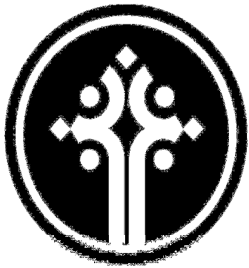
